

Instructions on 'How to Find Us'

Erw Newydd is situated in rural Anglesey in the parish of Tyn-y-Gongl, just outside Benllech some 12 miles (25 minutes) from the Britannia Bridge (A55) crossing.

To find us, after crossing over the Menai Strait, onto Ynys Mon (the Island of Anglesey) and leaving your troubles behind, follow these instructions.

Assuming you are travelling on the A55 Expressway, take the A5025 Benllech and Amlwch turn-off from the A55. This is the second exit, almost immediately after crossing Britannia bridge. At the top of the slip road turn right onto Lon Plant.

Stay on this road (the A5025 to Amlwch) crossing over the roundabout at Four Crosses and onto Pentraeth Road. After about four and a half miles, you will drop down a hill into Pentraeth and pass a Spa garage and supermarket on the left. This is a good place to stop for any last minute supplies. It also has a post office and a cash machine.

Proceed through Pentraeth, which has a well enforced thirty miles per hour limit, along Bangor Road until you get to Benllech, a distance of about 9 miles (15 minutes) from the bridge.

Proceed past the Medical Centre and the Co-op, both on the right-hand side of the road. You are now in Benllech village so lookout for Tesco's store which is on the left at the junction (see below). This is your last chance to stop as there are no more shops between Tesco and Erw Newydd.

Turn left immediately before the store and proceed up the hill, passing the chip shop on the right (very good fish & chips).

Continue along this road (the B5108 signposted Llangefni), past the golf club on your right, up to the crossroads with our local pub, the California Hotel, on the corner.

Turn right here onto the B5110 towards Marian-glas, passing Rhos Garage on the left. Look out for the signpost to our local church. The signpost is on a left-hand bend with a turn to the right.

Take that turn to the right towards the church but take care as you are now on a single track road with limited passing places. Continue for a quarter of a mile to a sharp left-hand bend with a driveway right on the corner.

You have arrived at Erw Newydd! Turn sharp right on to the drive, park your car and make yourself known.

Please note that if you are using a GPS the directions above may be different from those offered by your GPS which may bypass Benllech and bring you to the little church on the right handside of the road and about 250 metres away from Erw Newydd.

If so, get the church on your left hand side by turning round (if necessary). Then proceed to the junction and bear right up the gentle hill, at the top of which is the cottage, on the left, on the bend, about 100 yards from the junction.

These written directions minimise the use of single track roads and present an easy route to follow.
